08.20 <u>Chorley Council Tax Support Consultation</u>

A proposal for parish councils to contribute a small amount towards council tax support for low income claimants, which would result in a negligible reduction in the amount of precept received was considered.

Resolved: support for the proposal was expressed and the contribution agreed.

09.20 <u>2020-21 Precept</u>

The Precept for 2020-21 was considered. A revised draft budget was presented, which took into account the potential council tax support contribution, resulting in no increase in the Parish Council portion of council tax to residents. A proposal to reduce the Hub budget by £2500 was made. An amendment was tabled to hold the cost to residents at the current level.

Resolved: the Precept for 2020 - 2021 was set at £45734, which will result in no increase in the cost of the Parish Council portion of council tax to residents.

10.20 <u>Councillor Appointments</u>

As a result of a resignation, replacement members for the Personnel and Village Activities Committees were required.

Resolved: Cllr Heath was appointed to the Personnel Committee.

Resolved: Cllr Burns was appointed to the Village Activities Committee.

An additional Local Trustee for the Peter Lathom Charity was required.

Resolved: Cllr Bonney was appointed.

Councillors were required to work alongside the Hub Committee regarding the potential redevelopment of the premises.

Resolved: Cllr M Miller was appointed.

11.20 <u>Central Lancashire Local Plan Issues and Options Consultation</u>

A consultation by the Central Lancashire Authorities relating to suggestions for potential housing sites was discussed. It was noted sites off Tincklers Lane and Parr Lane were designated a safeguarded for development and would be included.

A response is to be submitted advising the Council does not support any building outside of the defined village settlement area.

As the next Neighbourhood meeting has been cancelled pending revised ward boundaries, this item was withdrawn.

13.20 Chorley Liaison Meeting
