Information on the planning for the Tincklers Lane development was provided. Recent instances of flooding of properties and the road in the vicinity of the proposed development were reported. Concerns have been raised regarding these instances being exacerbated if the field, which currently absorbs surface water in the area, disappears under the new properties. Details of the poor performance of water and sewerage companies on a national basis was also provided.
