## 28.18 Apologies for absence

Apologies were received from Councillors L Armstrong, J Holborn and W Mason.

#### 29.18 Disclosure of Personal/Prejudicial Interests

# 30.18 Minutes of the Meeting held on 8 February 2018

Resolved: the minutes of the meeting held on 8 February 2018 (as circulated) were approved and signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

## 31.18 Matters Arising

18.18 The hedge on The Hawthorns Play Area has been cut.

Resolved: Standing Orders were suspended.

# 32.18 Public Participation

A resident advised Lancashire County Council had granted permission for the hanging of large plastic Poppies on lampposts for the Remembrance period. Donations had been received for 25 Poppies and fund raising events are to be arranged.

Problems with dog fouling on the Millennium Green were reported.

Residents of Gillcroft offered support for the suggestion to tarmac grass verges in the area.

A ditch near the junction of Bradley Lane and Parr lane was reported as blocked and was causing flooding to land across the raod.

Resolved: Standing Orders were restored.

Resolved: Item 9 was brought forward.

#### 33.18 Verges on Gillcroft

Responses to the survey of residents of Gillcroft and part of The Fields regarding replacing grass verges with tarmac to provide better parking facilities was discussed. There were 12 responses, 11 in favour, together with a petition in favour from 41 properties, 6 of whom had also responded directly.

Resolved: Lancashire County Council is to be asked to look into the tarmacking of the verges.

18/00131/MNMA Minor non-material amendment to planning approval 16/01191/FUL: -Substitution of the 1.2-1.5m hawthorn hedge planted to either side of a 1.2m post and rail fence shown on the approved 'Proposed Layout' Ref. AL-001 REV M along Tincklers Lane to the front of Plots 1, 6 and 7 for a 0.9-1.9m brick retaining wall. - Erection of a 0.9-1.7m brick retaining wall with a feather edge boarded screen fence atop on the boundary with 75 Towngate - Proposed hawthorn hedge to the rear side of the retaining wall fronting Tincklers Lane at land adjacent to 75 Towngate. It was mentioned the new pavement appears to encroach into the road and the Planning Authority is to be asked to ensure the pavement is built in accordance with approved plans.

Resolved: a part of Item 14 was brought forward.
